Volunteers are a key part of the program's success. Thanks to tutors' support, 90% of AHC's teens graduate from high school and go to college.

AHC Inc. is a nonprofit developer of affordable rental housing. Founded in 1975, AHC is the largest owner of affordable housing in Arlington with 19 properties located throughout the county.

Many families living at AHC properties struggle to make ends meet and have limited time to devote to their families.

To meet this need, AHC began offering onsite Resident Services in 1993, including high-quality programs for children and teens. The program is working. Youngsters are improving their grades, staying in school, and going to college – many the first in their families.

## After-School Programs

AHC's After-School programs focus on improving literacy for elementary students. Staff and volunteers build reading, writing and vocabulary skills through a variety of educational and cultural activities.



## Teen Tutoring

AHC's program for middle and high school students aims to keep teens in school and help them maximize their options after high school. Components include weekly tutoring, mentoring, college visits, skills workshops and cultural experiences. Volunteers work one-on-one with teens at least one night a week, for about 90 minutes.

## Summer Camp/Teen Programs

Designed to prevent summer learning loss, this program provides both educational and fun activities for elementary children and teens.
