AHC Part of Arlington's Permanent Supportive Housing Program

More than a third of Arlington's [Supportive Housing Program](#) is in AHC communities. The program, which integrates affordable housing and community services for people who face the most complex challenges, including very low incomes and disability issues, currently includes 160 permanent apartments. Supportive housing also helps reduce costs to the community, particularly for shelter care and emergency medical treatment.
