Greater Baltimore AHC Names Andrew Vincent Housing Director
(Arlington, VA) – AHC Inc., one of the Washington-Baltimore area’s largest developers of affordable housing, is pleased to announce the promotion of Andrew M. Vincent to Housing Director at Greater Baltimore AHC.

Vincent joined Greater Baltimore AHC in the fall of 2004 and was promoted to Acting Director in January 2007. Now as Housing Director, he is responsible for overseeing the acquisition, development, financing and rehabilitation of single- and multi-family projects in the Baltimore area. Vincent earned a Master’s Degree in Real Estate Development from Columbia University, graduated *cum laude* from Carleton College with a B.A. in Economics, and is a member of the Urban Land Institute.

Based in Arlington, VA, AHC Inc. has developed a total of 3,253 units in 27 properties in Virginia and Maryland. Five years ago, AHC Inc. established AHC Greater Baltimore to preserve the supply of affordable housing for low- and moderate-income families and individuals living in Baltimore and to coordinate social services to improve the quality of residents’ lives. Today, AHC Greater Baltimore operates three rental communities comprised of 495 affordable apartments. Two new projects, Franklin Square with 72 units and Greenhill Housing with 301 units, are projected to bring an additional 373 affordable homes to the Baltimore area in the next two years.
