Arlington Notes

HOUSING COMPLEX APPROVED FOR NAUCK: Construction is slated to begin next spring on a housing effort that will further redevelopment in the Nauck community.

County Board members on Sept. 13 approved a use permit for a 36-unit apartment project along Shirlington Road at South Garfield Street, along with space for a non-profit development organization that will occupy the ground floor.

The project is a cooperative effort of Macedonia Baptist Church, which owns the property, and AHC Inc., which is acting as developer. The project will be located to the north of the new Townes of Shirlington development, part of the ongoing revitalization of one of Arlington's historically-black communities.

One AHC official said that while the timetable for beginning the project remains "fluid," it is expected that it will begin sometime in the spring of 2009.
