## Westover Renovation Slated to Begin

*Historic renovation will significantly update 1940s garden apartment complex*

With financing approved and construction permit in hand, the renovation of the 152-unit [Westover Apartments](#) is slated to begin in early September. The seven-acre apartment community, located in Arlington's Westover neighborhood, was purchased by AHC in 1985. The extensive restoration, expected to take 18 months, will maintain the community's historic ambiance, while completely updating all units with new kitchens, baths, windows, electrical, plumbing, HVAC systems and roofs.

## Summer Camp Wraps Up Successful Season

*Youngsters enjoyed the blend of educational, cultural and fun experiences.*

More than 100 children and teens enjoyed AHC's Summer Camp this year. Activities included weekly swimming outings, outdoor adventures and visits to cultural landmarks like the Natural History Museum. Children also participated in a variety of educational opportunities, including the "Give Me 10" Reading program, which challenged youngsters to read at least 10 books during the camp. An added bonus this year -- a summer internship grant from Arlington County that enabled 10 teens from AHC communities to work with the Summer Camp.
