Development Strategies

Mixed-Income Communities



AHC is partnering to create communities that provide homes for a variety of incomes, from low-income to workforce to market-rate.

Opening in the fall 2023, Waterfront Station II in Washington, DC, is a mixed-use, mixed-income development in the growing Southwest neighborhood. Located three blocks from The Wharf, the development has 449 apartments, with nearly a third (136) designated for affordable housing.

Preservation of Affordable Homes

In partnership with Fairfax County Redevelopment and Housing Authority, AHC and Insight acquired Haven Reston in Fairfax County, VA, in 2022. Previously a naturally occurring affordable community with no rent restrictions to safeguard affordability, the 259-apartment community is now as preserved affordable for 30 years.

Sustainable and Green Development

AHC's developments earn top environmental certifications, which saves residents money and benefits the community. The Apex in Arlington, VA, includes 256 apartments with the highest environmental standards and complements the local watershed plan.

Faith-Based Partnerships



Partnerships between churches and affordable housing create long-term community benefits. St. James Plaza in Alexandria, VA, transformed church-owned land into 93 affordable apartments, an onsite preschool, and market-rate townhomes.

Neighborhood Revitalization

AHC is deeply committed to the neighborhoods we serve. At Key's Pointe in Baltimore City, MD, 144 new townhome-style homes have been constructed. This is part of a massive, phased 62-acre revitalization of O'Donnell Heights, a public housing community in Southeast Baltimore.
