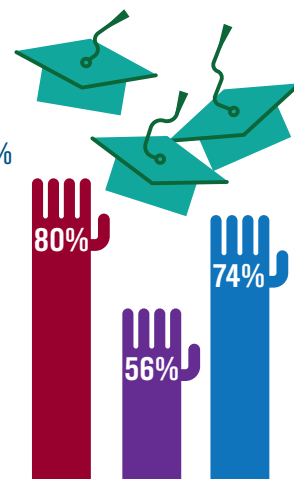

## Eviction Prevention



AHC helped 231 families in crisis avoid eviction.  
Savings to AHC - \$1 million\*

\*Along with keeping residents successfully housed and stabilizing families, AHC's eviction prevention program eliminates significant turnover costs, including lost rent; costs to clean, paint, etc when apartment is vacated; marketing services; and legal fees.

## AHC Student Success 2017-2018 School Year

- Afterschool Program - 93% read on grade level or made meaningful progress.
- Teen Program - 68% maintained an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Summer Camp - 94% maintained or improved reading levels.
- College and Career Readiness Program - 100% graduated from high school and attended college.
