Throughout her career, Cunningham has worked closely with community nonprofits, governments, and private sector leaders throughout the DC Metropolitan Area, from building public schools in DC, Baltimore, and Arlington, to designing sustainable buildings and serving on nonprofit boards in Montgomery County. Much of Cunningham’s work has focused on building successful organizations and diverse communities that support stable and productive lives for residents across the region.

A long-time Arlington County resident herself, Cunningham is deeply familiar with Arlington and the broader region. She serves on the Arlington County Board’s Joint Facilities Advisory Committee, Lee Highway Alliance, and is a member of the NAACP Arlington branch. Cunningham recently chaired the Hamm Middle School Building Level Planning Committee and co-chaired the Arlington Public Schools Superintendent’s Committee for Historic Interpretation at Stratford Junior High School.

To AHC, Cunningham brings both a longstanding commitment to affordable housing and multi-sector experience designing, constructing, and operating buildings. She has financed, built, and operated staff apartments, student dormitories, classrooms, and community spaces for public boarding schools. True to AHC’s mission, Cunningham has long championed sustainable design and operation of affordable housing across the DC Metropolitan Area.

She is the CEO and Founder of C2 Change Solutions, a consulting firm that helps organizations conceive, catalyze, and carry out lasting change. In her previous roles, Cunningham worked as a Senior Expert at McKinsey & Company, as a Co-Founder and Director of the Office of Compliance Analytics (OCA) at the U.S. Department of Treasury, Internal Revenue Service (IRS), and as a Director of New Schools Development at the Seed Foundation and Seed Public Charter School. She holds an M.S. and B.S. degrees in Mechanical Engineering from Yale University and served as a Fulbright Fellow and Visiting Lecturer in Applied Physics and Renewable Energy at University of Malawi.
